E.2 INSPECTION AND ACCEPTANCE (SEP 2001 - DITCO/DTS6).

a. Final inspection and acceptance of all work, performance, reports and other deliverables under this contract shall be performed at the location specified in individual task orders (TO). Each TO will also designate the individual responsible for inspection and acceptance, as well as the basis for acceptance. TO deliverable items that are rejected shall be corrected in accordance with the applicable clauses.

b. The basis for acceptance shall be in compliance with the requirements set forth in Section C, Statement of Work (SOW); task orders; and other terms and conditions of the contract. Deliverable items rejected under resulting task orders shall be corrected in accordance with the applicable clauses.

c. The Government requires a period not to exceed thirty (30) days after receipt of final deliverable item(s) for inspection and acceptance or rejection, unless otherwise specified in the individual TO.

E.3 ACCESS TO RECORD, DATA AND FACILITIES (SEP 2001 - DITCO/DTS6).

The contractor shall permit the Contracting Officer (KO) and/or designated representatives access at any reasonable time to all records, data and facilities used in performance of the contemplated services.

E.4 DATA FORMAT, INSPECTION AND ACCEPTANCE (FAR 46.401(b) and 46.503) (SEP 2001 - DITCO/DTS6).

Inspection and acceptance requirements for data items will be specified in each TO, either on separate DD Forms 1423, or incorporated into the deliverables schedule of the SOW, and made a part of each TO issued under this contract. The format of data items may be in submitted contractor format if so specified by the customer agency.

E.5 QUALITY CONTROL (SEP 2001 - DITCO/DTS6).

The contractor shall develop, implement and maintain a quality control program. This program shall include inspection, validation, evaluation, corrective action and procedures necessary to effect quality control of all performance and products provided under the contract. The program shall allow inspection and evaluation by the Government, and shall be applicable to all subcontractors and members of the contractor's team, as appropriate.
