CLAUSES INCORPORATED BY FULL TEXT

52.246-9101 BASIS FOR ACCEPTANCE (SEP 2001 – DITCO/DTS6)
(IAW FAR 46.401(b) and 46.503)

a. Final inspection and acceptance of all work, performance, reports and other deliverables under this contract shall be performed at the location specified in individual Task Orders (TO). Each TO will also designate the individual responsible for inspection and acceptance, as well as the basis for acceptance. TO deliverable items that are rejected shall be corrected in accordance with the applicable clauses.

b. The basis for acceptance shall be in compliance with the requirements set forth in Section C, Statement of Work (SOW); task orders; and other terms and conditions of the contract. Deliverable items rejected under resulting task orders shall be corrected in accordance with the applicable clauses.

c. The Government requires a period not to exceed thirty (30) days after receipt of final deliverable item(s) for inspection and acceptance or rejection, unless otherwise specified in the individual TO.

52.246-9102 DATA FORMAT, INSPECTION AND ACCEPTANCE (SEP 2001 – DITCO/DTS6)
