CLAUSES INCORPORATED BY FULL TEXT

**TASK ORDERS (TOs) PERFORMANCE PERIOD AND PRICING, 52.216-9203 (F504) MAR 2001).**

a. TOs may be issued during any of the contract years. The performance period for each TO will be specified in the TO and may extend beyond expiration date of this contract.

b. TOs shall be priced using the Section B rates that will be applicable to the TO's anticipated period of performance. For purposes of task orders issued during the final year of this contract (or any subsequent 6-month option for continued service), the final contract year's pricing shall be used. This means that during basic proposal preparation and award, it is understood that pricing for task orders issued during the last contract year reflects the possibility of continuation beyond the end of the contract period.

**52.211-9103 DELIVERY SCHEDULE FOR REPORTS AND OTHER DELIVERABLES (IAW FAR 11.401(a) and 15.204-2(f)) (FEB 1998)**

The work and services required under this contract shall be completed and delivered to the specified address(es) in accordance with the delivery dates contained in individual TO statements of work (SOWs). The place of delivery shall be included in the TO SOW, or, in the case of data, within the SOW or in an appropriately detailed Contract Data Requirements List, DD Form 1423.

**52.211-9200 PERIOD OF CONTRACT (F500 Previously) (JUN 1996)**

Any contract awarded as a result of an offer submitted in response to this solicitation shall be effective from date of contract award and shall continue for a period of six years, unless sooner terminated under the terms of this contract.

**52.211-9201 PLACE OF PERFORMANCE (F501 Previously) (JUN 1996)**

The contractor may be required to perform work associated with task orders (TOs) in any of the 50 states. In addition, the contractor may be required to perform work in all countries in which U.S. Government Departments and Agencies have a presence. Services under this contract shall be performed at the locations specified in the individual TOs.
